Dr. Ron Schmidt Student Travel Award



This award was created in honor of Dr. Ronald H. Schmidt, Professor Emeritus, of Gainesville, FL, who passed away on October 12, 2020. His teaching career with the University of Florida Food Science and Human Nutrition Department spanned almost 40 years and Ron was an internationally known expert on food safety and sanitary design. He traveled the world to speak, train, and consult. He published dozens of scientific papers and authored or contributed to 25 books and he was one of the founders of 3-A SSI.

Above all, Ron was passionate about engaging 3-A SSI to inspire the next generation of food industry professionals to learn about all aspects of hygienic equipment design and food safety. Through his leadership, the 3-A SSI travel award began in 2010 and today honors his legacy for those setting a professional course in a food-related career.

The **Dr. Ron Schmidt Student Travel Award** provides an opportunity for qualified full-time students enrolled in a relevant field of study to attend the **2023 3-A SSI Education Program and Annual Meeting, May 9-11, 2023** at the Hilton Minneapolis/St. Paul Mall of America in Bloomington, MN. This program is intended for students who seek to supplement their classroom training with greater practical knowledge about all aspects of hygienic design for equipment and systems used in food processing.

Application Deadline: March 20, 2023

Eligibility Criteria

- Demonstrate interest and commitment to food safety and quality as a student enrolled fulltime in a food technology, food science, dairy science or other closely related program (undergraduate or graduate level) at an accredited college or university in the U.S. or Canada at the time of the application deadline.
- Submit a single application package by March 20, 2023 with all of the following;
 - ✓ Candidate Application Form Complete the attached form.
 - ✓ **Statement of Interest** Explain your interest in hygienic equipment design/food safety, your career objective, and what you hope to gain from participating in the 3-A SSI events.
 - ✓ Letter of Recommendation From a faculty member or department head.
